Please be advised that this schedule may change due to weather and existing conditions found while performing the tasks below. This work may impact traffic and require lane and sidewalk closures limiting access to driveways and entrances to businesses.

What to Expect for the Week of September 26, 2022, to September 30, 2022

Project Wide

- Raise castings on manholes project wide – the eastbound detour from Pleasant Street to Maple Street to Hayden Rowe will be utilized.

East Side of Project

- Eversource duct bank work from Ash Street to the eastern project limit; a single lane of alternating traffic will be used
- Continue the service connections up to property lines from the Muffin House to Ash Street.

West Side of Project

- Continue Grading and Compacting sidewalks between Wood Street and the Fire Station
- Continue forming and pouring Concrete Sidewalks from Wood Street towards the Fire Station
- Concrete sidewalk work at end of driveways; affected property owners will be notified in advance.
- Line striping of pavement on Wood Street; will be done one night beginning at 8pm;

135/85 Intersection

- Continue pouring and forming concrete sidewalks at the intersection (including Cedar and Grove Street)
- Concrete sidewalk work at end of driveways on Grove Street; affected property owners will be notified in advance
- Continue installation of light pole bases; installation of new light signals.
- Line striping of pavement at the intersection; will be done one night beginning at 8pm

Working hours for the Main Street Corridor Project are from 7am to 3pm. No detours, one lane closures or road closures are allowed between 7am and 9am.
