Please be advised that this schedule may change due to weather and existing conditions found while performing the tasks below. This work may impact traffic and require lane and sidewalk closures limiting access to driveways and entrances to businesses.

What to Expect for the Week of October 10, 2022, to October 14, 2022

East Side of Project

- Continue underground service connections up to property lines from the Muffin House to Ash Street

135/85 Intersection

- Install street lighting foundations and conduit
- Install new traffic signals at the 135/85 intersection
- Grading of sidewalk areas on Grove and Cedar Street
- Complete pavement on Grove Street (if Eversource's work is complete)
- Install curbing on Cedar and Grove Street (dependent on scheduling)
- Eastbound detour from Grove Street to Maple Street to Hayden Rowe will be used as needed for the above work

West Side of Project

- Continue fine grading and compacting sidewalks from Wood Street towards the Fire Station
- Complete driveways on West Main Street (dependent on scheduling)
- Concrete sidewalk work at end of driveways; affected property owners will be notified in advance.
- Asphalt work at end of driveways for properties that have an asphalt driveway apron; homeowners will be notified - westbound traffic on Main Street will be detoured to Wood St as needed

Working hours for the Main Street Corridor Project are from 7am to 3pm. No detours, one lane closures or road closures are allowed between 7am and 9am.
